FACULTY INFORMATION

Faculty teaching at the Ardmore Higher Education Center are employed by the institution whose courses they teach. On average, 75 percent are regular and 25 percent are specialized adjunct faculty. At the university level, 50 percent of the faculty hold doctorate degrees. The student-faculty ratio is 15 to 1.
