Transfer Students

Minimum college GPA required – 2.0

Maximum credits transferable – 84

TOEFL test requirements – Undergraduate students whose native language is not English must achieve a score of 500 or higher.

COSTS

Tuition – \$22,250. Oklahoma City University also offers a 4-year fixed-rate tuition plan. Undergraduate students can elect to fix the undergraduate tuition block price at \$12,000 per semester.

Academic service fees – \$2,100

Books and supplies – \$1,500
