English (Grammar, Composition, Literature) 4 units
Lab Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics, or any lab science certified by the school district; General Science with or without a lab may not be used to meet this requirement.) 2 units
Mathematics (from Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, Trigonometry, Math Analysis, Calculus) 3 units
History and citizenship skills (including 1 unit of American History and 2 units from subjects of History, Economics, Geography, Government, Non-Western Culture)* 3 units

Application process – Submit completed application and a high school transcript containing cumulative GPA, class rank, graduation date and ACT/SAT score.

Application deadlines – Fall (August 26); Spring (Jan. 22)

Transfer Students

Minimum college GPA required – 2.0

Maximum credits transferable – A minimum of 60 hours must be taken at RSU in order to receive a bachelor's degree from RSU

Items required for application – Admissions application, transcripts from every college attended, a high school transcript (if applicant has taken less than 24 college credit hours), ACT or SAT scores (if applicant has taken less than 24 college credit hours or they are not cleared by a college-level class in a certain area).

International Students

TOEFL test requirements – Demonstrate English proficiency, if English is a second language, in one of the following ways –

Students from the following countries are exempt from taking the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL): Australia, Canada, England, Jamaica, New Zealand, Trinidad, and West Africa.

Official TOEFL score of 500+ on the written examination, or Official TOEFL score of 173+ on the computerized examination, or

Official TOEFL score of 460+ and successful completion of a 12-week Intensive English Program (IEP) approved by the Oklahoma State Regents to be immediately followed by enrollment at RSU, or

Graduate from an English speaking high school.
