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Purpose. The purpose of the Student Advisory Board is to communicate to the State Regents the views and interests of all Oklahoma college and university students on issues that relate to the constitutional and statutory responsibilities of the State Regents. In representing students, the Student Advisory Board shall combine the opinions of students with good, sound research to develop the best proposals and recommendations for The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education.

Creation. The creation of this board is consistent with provisions of House Bill Number 1801 of the 1988 Oklahoma Legislature. Seven members are elected annually by delegates to the Oklahoma Student Government Association. Members represent public tier and independent colleges, and they serve a one-year term (May through April).

Student Advisory Board Recommendations and Counsel to State Regents

Articulation. The Board continued the work of the previous year to promote credit transfer.

Student Voice. The Board promoted the right of students to participate in institutional governance.

International Education. The Board promoted the coordination of international programs in Oklahoma.

Funding Documentation. The Board called for full disclosure of accounting procedures at state institutions.

Accelerated Degrees. The Board supported the implementation of 3-year degree programs.
