Saul presented the printed proposed work plan and the items were discussed:

1. Enrollment on-line
2. Posting of exit surveys on-line.
3. Work to get Hotels to offer students discounts to cut down on night driving when the student is too tired to drive.

Side Items to be looked at:

- a) A centralized database of e-mail addresses for faculty/students/staff.
- b) Tax free week to be studied. We discussed how this was working out for those that have it. Do the rest of us want it? How does it tie in with Oklahoma?
- c) Group discounted insurance for students.
- d) Alcohol policies to be examined for parity and fairness.
- e) We support responsible internet usage.

Old items reviewed:

- 1 Computer group purchase and the use of scholarship money to pay for purchases.
- 2 Extension of Library and computer center hours.
- 3 E-mail for all students provided by the institutions.
- 4 Capstone programs.
- 5 Experiential and competency based programs.

6 Campus Compact and its current status. Saul leaving for Rhode Island conference and will brief us on it's content. The compact will be formally announced at a meeting on October 24th with press coverage. Colleges still have time to sign on and be considered original members before the press meeting.
