4. **Overview of Academic Advisement – Dr. Joyce Allman, Associate Provost for Academic Advising, University of Oklahoma** – Dr. Allman discussed the varying types of advisement by institution and asked the SAB members to describe their issues and experiences. She also discussed the National College Academic Advising Association, and its programs for professional development of advisors. The national association is also used as a repository for research. The Oklahoma College Academic Counselors Association at the state level, hosts two conferences, one held in the fall, the other in the spring; these also help with advising professionalism, strategic advising, and development.
