1. Call to Order. Notice that meeting has been filed and posted in accordance with Open Meetings Act
2. Announcement of Quorum

Debbie Blanke and Debbie Terlip of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education Student Services Division called the meeting to order at 1:15 p.m. with a quorum of 6 members present. Introductions were made.

Members Present: Robert Couch, Tanner Hurst, Logan Hutto, Kailey Kelpine, Clayton Myers and Palmer Tetley. Members Absent: Rosa San Roman

3. Recognition of Invited Guests

Keirney Robinson Large, Vice President of the Student Government Association at Langston University, and Traeton Dansby, President of the Oklahoma Student Government Association, were present.

4. Swearing In of New Member Logan Hutto, Oklahoma State University

Debbie Blanke swore Logan Hutto, Oklahoma State University, into office.

5. Student Advisory Board Orientation - Ms. Debbie Terlip, Executive Director, Oklahoma Campus Compact, and Student Relations Manager, Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education

Debbie Terlip reviewed key material that is on the Student Advisory Board site on the State Regents website. She also familiarized the members with information about the Oklahoma State System for Higher Education on the State Regents website, and offered some context for the information with ongoing issues and activities.

6. Student Affairs Overview - Dr. Debbie Blanke, Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs, Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education

Debbie Blanke gave a brief overview of the State Regents Council on Student Affairs, its purpose and the work its members do, and mentioned some of the current issues in their work plan, such as freedom of speech on campus.

7. Planning for Student Advisory Board Meeting with Chancellor Glen D. Johnson, in joint meeting with the Oklahoma Student Government Association Board of Directors, and Council of Student Presidents – September 22, 2019 at Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education in Oklahoma City

Debbie Terlip said the student leaders will get to hear the presentation on the state of higher education in Oklahoma and current issues which Chancellor Johnson gives the legislature and business leaders across the state. She said this is an opportunity for the students to dialogue with the Chancellor about issues of concern to them.

8. Discussion of Election of 2019-2020 Student Advisory Board Chair and Vice-Chair

Debbie Terlip announced that the SAB members would elect a chair and vice chair at the Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting, and talked about the duties for these offices.

9. Planning for Student Advisory Board Involvement in Student Leadership Retreat, September 27, 2019 at the University of Central Oklahoma in Edmond

Debbie Terlip described the purpose, schedule and activities for the annual Student Leadership Retreat, and reviewed the duties which the SAB members who attended would be requested to undertake in the student sessions.

10. Update on Oklahoma Student Government Association/Council of Student Presidents Activities - Mr. Traeton Dansby, President, OSGA

Traeton described the OSGA Board's plans for the year. He is creating a new cabinet to the president of four members for the following duties: Coordinator of Lobbying, Coordinator of Fund-Raising, President's Advisor, and Coordinator for Community. Briefly describing the duties of each office, he said that their availability has been advertised, and the Board is receiving applications. Traeton next talked about the SGA Presidents Retreat, which will be Sept. 21-22 in Oklahoma City. The SGA Presidents are invited to join the SAB and OSGA Board at the Sept. 22<sup>nd</sup> meeting in the State Regents offices with Chancellor Johnson. The Board also plans to continue to expand OSGA's presence outside of Fall and Spring Congress, beginning with being on campus more. With regard to Fall and Spring Congress, since the State Capitol will not be available due to ongoing interior construction in the fall, the Board is taking bids from institutions to host Fall Congress, and hoping to host Spring Congress at the Capitol. Potential dates for Fall Congress are Nov. 9–10, and Nov. 23–24.

11. Determination of Agenda for Next Meeting

Debbie Terlip briefly talked about issues studied by SAB members in the past, said there would be some presentations which the State Regents offer, such as an overview of the Oklahoma's Promise and other state student aid programs, and asked the members to be thinking about issues they would like to study during the course of the year. She said she will work with the members to bring in informative people for areas the SAB members would like to explore. Kailey Kelpine mentioned that she is interested in DACA students and higher education, and safety/weapons on campus issues. Robert Couch said he is interested in student mental health and the availability of mental health services for students, and in disability services.

12. New Business. Consideration of other matters not known or not reasonably foreseen prior to the time of agenda posting

Debbie Terlip noted that the proposed SAB meeting dates for the academic year had not been considered at the May 2019 swearing-in and orientation, and presented the schedule to the SAB for its consideration. Kailey Kelpine made a motion to approve the schedule as presented, which was seconded and approved unanimously.

### 13. Adjournment

There being no new business, the meeting adjourned at 2:50 p.m.
