# 2004-2005 Student Advisory Board to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education

## WORKPLAN

### **TOP PRIORITIES:**

This year the Student Advisory Board has collaborated with the Oklahoma Student Government Association to create a joint Plan for Action (see attached document). The Plan for Action will serve as the primary focus of the Board for the 2004-2005 academic year. Key items include:

- Support for the Capitol Bond Issue
- Support for Higher Educations' Fair Share of State Appropriations
- Support for the EDGE initiative, specially exploring the possibility of state income tax exemption for Oklahoma graduates and other tax exemptions for Oklahoma corporations.
- Work with State Regents staff to design a strategy that helps all Oklahoma college students become aware of the purpose, role, and scope of the OSGA and SAB.

#### **ONGOING RESEARCH PROJECTS:**

- **Teacher Enhancement**: Because effective teaching/learning strategies lead to higher retention and graduation rates, the Board will examine ways to improve teaching/learning productivity on Oklahoma campuses.
- **Study Abroad**: The board will examine how to better promote study abroad programs on Oklahoma campuses, specifically exploring ways to make information on study abroad opportunities easily accessible to students.

#### Student Advisory Board to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education
