## FACULTY ADVISORY COUNCIL Minutes

- 2. Environmental sustainability;
- 3. Veteran student services;
- 4. Student preparedness related to non-cognitive factors such as coping strategies, resilience and lifestyle; and
- 5. Communication among faculty.
