FACULTY ADVISORY COUNCIL Minutes

ICAP Presentation

Theresa Shaklee, Student Portal Coordinator, Oklahoma College Assistance Program and Lisa Nelson, Director of Student Preparation, OSRHE provided information about the Individual Career and Academic Plan (ICAP) that requires all incoming high school freshman (Fall, 2019) to complete for high school graduation. The term ICAP refers to both a process that helps students engage in academic and career development activities and a product that is created and maintained for students' academic, career and personal advancement. The co-presenters and FAC members discussed ways the ICAP will/could impact post-secondary experiences.

Online Consortium

Kyler Foster, Assistant Director of Academic & Student Affairs Degree Completion Initiatives, OSRHE provided an Online Consortium update. FAC members were provided with a list of institutions currently participating in the Online Consortium and points of contact for each institution. Members were reminded about the annual Learning Innovation Summit that is open to all members of Oklahoma institutions. Additionally, members were informed that consortium members can watch any of the recorded webinars if they are unable to attend in person. The Council on Online Learning Excellence (COLE) and members of the Online Consortium are discussing potential opportunities to develop webinars to provide certification for post-secondary faculty to teach online.
