



Colleges currently using College Career Math Ready (CCMR) course to determine college-level math placement:

Carl Albert State College	If students successfully complete the course, this college will waive math remediation requirements. Successful completion of the course will put students in college algebra, survey of contemporary math, or elementary statistics.
Connors State College	If a student completes the course with an A or B, students will be placed into college-level gateway math courses.
Murray State College	Currently accepts CCMR as one of multiple measures for math placement.
Northwestern Oklahoma State University	Any student who earned an A or B in the CCMR course their senior year will be able to enroll in a credit bearing co-requisite class.
OSU-OKC	Accepting CCMR as a measure for math placement.
Redlands Community College	Cumulative High School GPA of 2.8 or higher and successful completion of H.S. Algebra II or College Career Math Ready with a B or better AND ACT Score 15 or higher can be placed in Co-requisite College Algebra. OR Graduated H.S. within the last 8 years with an unweighted GPA ≥ 3.0 WITH 3 years of HS math, including Algebra II/College Career Math Ready course enroll in MATH 1513: College Algebra.
Seminole State College	Students whose high school transcript shows completion of the CCMR Math Ready course with a grade of B or better will be permitted to enroll in college-level math without placement testing or remediation.
Western Oklahoma College	Students who complete the course with a B or higher will be placed into any college-level math course.
