DISABILITY SERVICES

WHEREAS, the population of non-traditional students and students with disabilities is increasing at many of Oklahoma's higher education institutions, and;

WHEREAS, higher education institutions need to be able to adequately assist this growing population, and;

WHEREAS, students with all types of disabilities need to be made fully aware of all services that a college has to offer.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Student Advisory Board and the Faculty Advisory Committee to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education:

- 1. That the State Regents work with institutions to ensure that proper access to disability services is available to all eligible students.
- 2. That the State Regents urge institutions to increase student awareness of campus disability services and communicate disability services to high school graduates early in the decision making process to help them choose the right fit at all higher education institutions.
- 3. That the awareness is communicated to the students at the beginning of their contact with the college or university.
