

ONLINE COURSE EVALUATION SUMMARIES

WHEREAS, many colleges and universities around the nation already provide online course evaluation summaries for student and potential student use, and;

WHEREAS, all Oklahoma institutions should provide the opportunity for students to evaluate their courses at the end of the semester, and;

WHEREAS, students who do not already attend a particular college or university can use these course evaluations to learn more about courses they may wish to take and the faculty who teach them, and;

WHEREAS, the standardized information that is collected from these course evaluations could be easily transferred to a format that can be posted on the institution's website, and;

WHEREAS, this information can benefit faculty and students by giving students a sense of what to expect from a course and the instructor which could help lead to a decrease in early semester dropout.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Student Advisory Board and the Faculty Advisory Committee to the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education:

1. That the State Regents collect institutional data regarding the availability of exit surveys and end of semester course evaluations by students at Oklahoma colleges and universities.
2. That the SAB will report the findings and any further recommendations in their year end report.
