



2022 Legislation

OKPromise - SB 1673

- Higher application income limit for families with more dependent children.
 - •\$60,000: 2 or less children
 - •\$70,000: 3-4 children
 - •\$80,000: 5 or more children

OKPromise - SB 1673

The bill does not change the current \$100,000 income limit for all OKPromise students enrolled in college or other postsecondary education.

National Guard Educational Assistance Act – SB 1418

- State System Colleges & Universities
- Subject to available funding.
- Potentially expanded benefits.

Oklahoma Future Teacher Scholarship & Employment Incentive Program HB 3564

Combines a college scholarship with an employment incentive for the first 5 years of teaching.

2022 Legislative Interim Study Requests

None appear directly related to student financial aid programs.

- Funding directed for specific purposes and programs, not general operating needs.
- Funding programs that directly benefit students.

Trends & Themes

- Emphasis on restraining tuition & fee increases (including proportionality of fees to tuition).
