SUBJECT: Financial Aid Update and Annual Student Financial Aid Survey for 2006-07

## RECOMMENDATION:

## This item is for information purposes. The Annual Student Financial Aid Survey is presented for the State Regents' acceptance.

## BACKGROUND:

For 33 consecutive years, the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education have compiled an Annual Financial Aid Report (OCR B3) for state system institutions. This report is used to track the amounts and types of financial aid distributed in Oklahoma public higher education institutions. The information is also compiled according to race and gender. The data helps to provide trend information on the long-term changes in the financial aid environment of students attending Oklahoma public colleges and universities. Information concerning grants, scholarships, loans, and employment is collected in aggregate form directly from the institutions.

For the third year, most private/independent colleges also provided aggregate information on students at their institutions.

## POLICY ISSUES:

The information provided by this report is critical for monitoring the impact of financial aid on the policy goals of the State Regents to increase the number of students earning college degrees in Oklahoma.


#### Abstract

ANALYSIS: In 2006-07, students attending Oklahoma public and independent (private) colleges and universities received financial aid totaling $\$ 1.22$ billion, an increase of $\$ 21$ million or less than $2 \%$ compared to 200506. Students at state system institutions received $\$ 941$ million while students at the independent institutions received $\$ 281$ million. Over half of the amount, some $\$ 655$ million or $53 \%$ was in the form of loans.


A few other highlights of the 2006-07 data are:

- The total amount of state system financial aid in 2006-07 was virtually unchanged compared to 2005-06. This small change is markedly different than the previous four years that saw annual increases of $5 \%, 16 \%, 11 \%$, and $15 \%$.
- Over the past three years, the percentage of students receiving any form of financial aid in the state system increased from $57 \%$ in 2004-05 to $60 \%$ in 2005-06 and to $63 \%$ in 2006-07.
- The number of state system students receiving the federal Pell Grant declined by about 4,300 or $7 \%$. The total dollar amount of Pell Grants awarded to state system students also declined by 7\% or $\$ 9.1$ million. A change in the federal formula that determines a student's eligibility for the Pell Grant appears to have contributed to this decline. The change, which modified a formula factor for state taxes paid, eliminated Pell Grant eligibility for some students and reduced the amount of the grant for others.
- According to federal data sources, 4,754 Oklahoma students received the new federal Academic Competitiveness Grant (ACG) in 2006-07 with a total value of $\$ 3.6$ million. Some 970 students received the new federal National Science Mathematics Access to Retain Talent (SMART) Grant worth a total of $\$ 2.9$ million.

## Trends for Students in the State System for Higher Education:

\$> After several years of significant increases, the volume of student loan borrowing by state system students actually decreased slightly from $\$ 507$ million in 2005-06 to about $\$ 502$ million in 2006-07. The amount of federal Pell Grants awarded also declined moderately.

>> The maximum Pell Grant in 2006-07 was $\$ 4,050$, virtually unchanged since 2002-03. In 2006-07, the maximum federal Pell Grant covered a smaller portion of public college costs than at any point since 1992-93. In 2007-08 (shown in chart), the maximum increased to $\$ 4,310$, enough to reverse the trend for students at two-year colleges.

## 2006-07 Financial Aid for Students Attending State System Institutions:

- About 148,000 students attending state system institutions received approximately $\$ 941$ million dollars in student aid. Just over $63 \%$ of the nearly 233,000 students attending state system institutions in 2006-07 received some form of financial aid.
- Over the past four years, the total amount of financial aid distributed to state system students increased by $\$ 247$ million, or $36 \%$. The amount of student loans borrowed by state students increased $42 \%$ over those four years.

- Student Loans:
o More than half ( $53 \%$, or $\$ 502$ million) of all financial aid dollars awarded were in loans. All other types of financial aid combined- scholarships, grants, and work-studytotaled slightly less than $\$ 439$ million (47\%).
o The percentage of all students taking out student loans has increased from $22 \%$ in 199495 to $31 \%$ in 2006-07.

2006-07 Financial Aid for Students Attending Independent/Private Institutions: For the third year, independent colleges participating in the Oklahoma Tuition Equalization Grant (OTEG) program were also required to submit aggregate financial aid data. In 2006-07, students attending independent institutions received $\$ 281$ million in total financial aid, of which $\$ 153$ million or $54 \%$ was in the form of loans. A more detailed summary of the sources of financial aid is included in Attachment B.

Combined 2006-07 Financial Aid for State System and Independent/Private Institutions: A total of $\$ 1.22$ billion in financial aid was disbursed to students attending Oklahoma public and independent colleges in 2006-07. The table below shows the proportion of aid coming from each source for the two sectors.
