

by Race/Ethnicity






six-year graduation rates



According to Oklahoma Works:

Require an associate's degree or higher

Oklahoma's 100
Critical Occupations
(2021-2030)



- Oklahoma's top 29 highest paying critical occupations in 2030 will require and associate's degree or higher
- >54 of the top 100 critical occupations in 2030 will require an associate's degree or higher
- **▶**8 of Oklahoma's top 10 fastest growing critical occupations in 2030 will require an associate's degree or higher

	Oklahoma Residents	Non-Residents who attend Oklahoma Institutions	Total Employment Rate
1-Year after Graduation	89.7%	65.6%	83.7%
5-Years after Graduation	87.5%	61.5%	81.3%

METHODOLOGY:

Data match between OSRHE, OESC, and OTC records to determine percent of state system graduates who remain in the state and are employed in the state 1-Year and 5-Years after graduation.
