

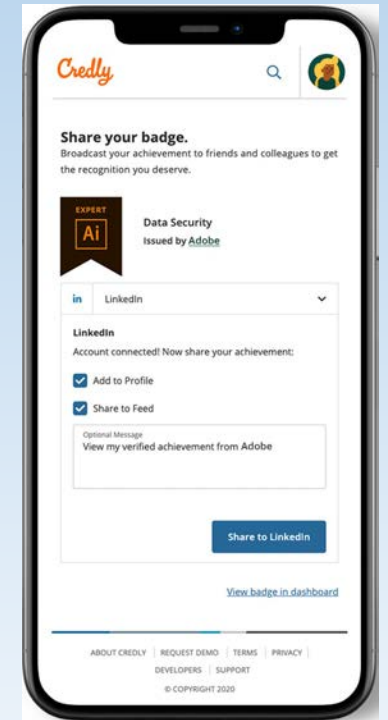
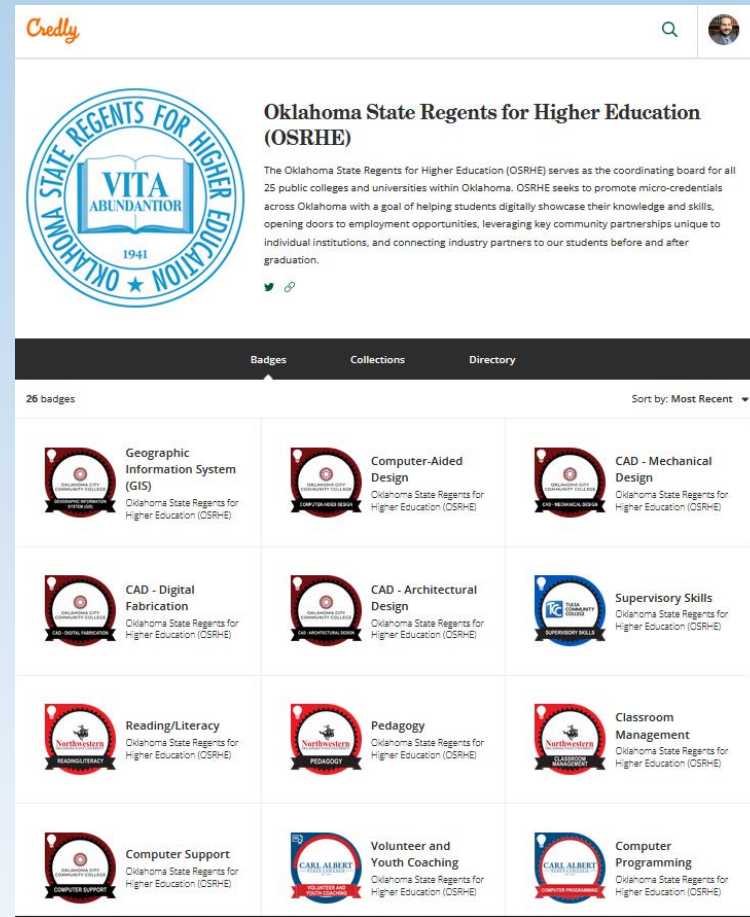
Grant Type	Description
\$2,500 Grant for Fully Authored Project	Funds a project fully authored by project collaborators and hosted on OPEN OCO with CC license

\$500 Grant for OER Adoption of Whole Resource	Funds the adoption of an existing OER on OPEN OCO with CC license

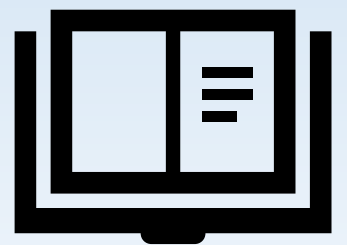
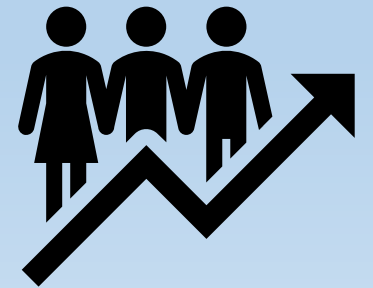
