## HIGHER EDUCATION IN OKLAHOMA



Associate and bachelor's degree holders earn a median income $25 \%$ and $75 \%$ higher, respectively, than those with only a high school diploma.


The number of engineering degrees and certificates conferred by state system institutions increased 43.1\% over the last decade, and STEM degrees increased $19.2 \%$ at all levels.


Only $\mathbf{2 8 . 5 \%}$ of Oklahoma citizens hold a bachelor's degree or higher. The national average is nearly $36 \%$, and of our surrounding states - including Arkansas, New Mexico, Missouri, Texas, Kansas and Colorado —only Arkansas has a lower percentage of citizens with a bachelor's degree or higher.

Over 37,000 degrees and certificates awarded at all levels in the last academic year, and an increase of nearly $6 \%$ over the last decade


Data from the National Center for Education Statistics show Oklahoma universities have the $8^{\text {th }}$-lowest cost of attendance in the nation.


Our students learn here, earn here - 96\% of Oklahomans who graduate from a state system college or university remain and work in the state one year after graduation.


Of Oklahoma's 100 critical occupations, the top 29 highest-paying jobs require an associate's degree or higher, and all of the top 10 require a bachelor's degree or higher.

## BY THE NUMBERS

## Enrollment

- During the 2022-23 academic year, 14,153 students enrolled at institutions in or adjacent to District 5 .


## Graduation

- During the 2022-23 academic year, 2,672 students graduated from institutions in or adjacent to District 5 .


## Oklahoma's Promise

- In District 5, 170 students from the 2023 high school graduating class qualified for the Oklahoma's Promise scholarship.
- Currently, 365 high school students in District 5 are enrolled in Oklahoma's Promise.
- Since inception in 1992, 2,845 high school students from District 5 have received the Oklahoma's Promise scholarship.
- During the 2022-23 academic year, nearly 1,100 students at public higher education institutions in or adjacent to District 5 received approximately $\$ 5.3$ million in scholarships from Oklahoma's Promise.


## Concurrent Enrollment

- During the 2022-23 academic year, 1,229 students enrolled in 9,768 credit hours through concurrent courses at institutions in or adjacent to District 5.
