- 1. ANNOUNCEMENT OF FILING OF MEETING NOTICE AND POSTING OF THE AGENDA IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE OPEN MEETING ACT. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education held a special meeting at 9 a.m. on Thursday, September 27, 2024, at the State Regents Office in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.
